- ❖ 4394 Internship: Prefix can be CGS, CLDP, NSC, PSY or SPAU (4396). Students earn course credit for field experience in an applied setting. Requires working at least 8 hours per week at an approved community agency or business of the student's choice. Students keep daily job diaries, attend two class meeting per month, and write brief papers relevant to their experiences. Open to students with a GPA of at least 2.5 who have reached junior or senior standing (more than 53 hours). Credit/No Credit only. - ❖ 4395 Co-op Fieldwork: Prefix can be CGS, CLDP, or PSY. Students earn course credit for field experience in an approved business or government setting. Students will keep a journal of their workplace experience, maintain contact with the instructor, and prepare a written report that focuses on the accomplishments and insights gained through their co-op experience.
